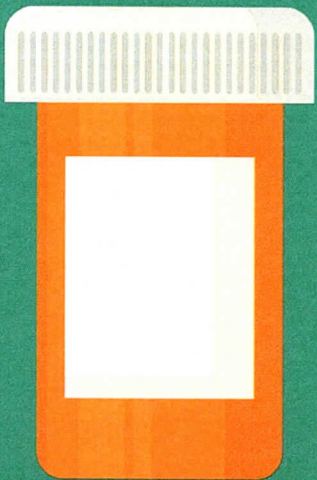

How to Use a Prescription Drug Drop Box!

OUR DROP BOX IS A SECURE, LOCKED STRUCTURE LOCATED AT THE LAKE VIEW POLICE DEPARTMENT. OUR STAFFED DROP BOX IS AVAILABLE DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS.

Procedure:

- 1. COLLECT YOUR UNUSED, UNWANTED, AND EXPIRED PRESCRIPTIONS IN A SECURE BAG.**
- 2. REMOVE ALL PERSONAL INFORMATION FROM YOUR CONTAINERS.**
- 3. LOCATE YOUR CLOSEST PRESCRIPTION DRUG DROP BOX AND DROP THEM THROUGH THE SLOT!**

ONLY ITEMS ACCEPTED:

- PRESCRIPTION MEDICINES
- OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICINES
- VITAMINS
- PET MEDICINES
- MEDICATED OINTMENTS & LOTIONS
- MEDICINE SAMPLES
- MEDICATION PATCHES

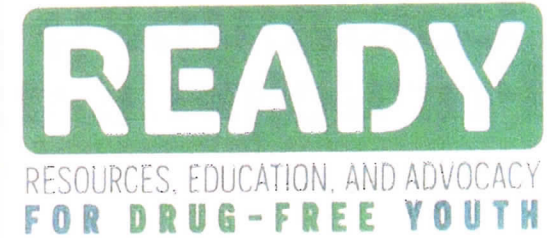

Have a little PRIDE

is a program for 3rd grader students in the City and County Systems of Tuscaloosa. The purpose of the program is to lay the groundwork for understanding addiction and to gain perspective on the benefits of making healthy lifestyle choices throughout their lifetime.

Middle & High School Programs

READY works within middle and high schools to provide students with drug & alcohol education lessons. This program is designed to educate the students on substances and prevent the onset of addiction. This program is implemented within these West Alabama Counties: Tuscaloosa, Bibb, Hale, Choctaw, Marengo, Sumter, Choctaw, Greene, & Pickens.

Juvenile Referral Program

is a collaborative referral resource program with the city and county alternative schools and juvenile court. It lasts 6 weeks and covers topics of communication, decision-making, harmful effects of substance abuse, and more.
